Bramley enjoys a vibrant local community spirit along with its thriving High Street where a local butcher, grocer, supermarket, and post office can be found. There are two very popular pubs as well as a library and historic church. The village has regular bus links to Guildford, Godalming, and Cranleigh. There is an excellent selection of schools in the area in both the state and private sector including St.Catherine's School for Girls

The county town of Guildford is just 4 miles away, with its quaint cobbled High Street and picturesque riverside scenes. Guildford offers excellent shopping with three covered shopping centres, restaurants, and recreational activities. The modern Spectrum Leisure Centre caters to those for enjoy sports, whilst the theatres and Odeon cinema provide great entertainment.
